

September 2017 Admissions Allocation Summary



St Philip's Primary School (the admissions Authority) received **113** 'on time' Reception applications by the statutory closing date, 15th January 2017. This includes 1st, 2nd & 3rd preference applications.

Because the number of allocations received exceeds the number of Reception places available (The published admissions number is **40**), a priority for the offer of places was determined in accordance with the requirements of the 2014 School Admissions Code using the 'Equal Preference With Ranking' procedure. This involves applications being ranked against the over subscription criteria set out in the 2017 school admission arrangements published by the Local Authority.

The following summary indicates the number of places offered against each oversubscribed criterion on 18th April 2017. The 40th place was offered against criterion **3** for a child living **0.628 miles** away from the school when measured by a straight line. This profile does not take account of late applications.

Criterion		Places offered
1	Children in Public care (Looked after Children) or a child who was previously looked after but immediately after being looked after became subject to an adoption, care arrangement order or special guardianship order	2
2	Children who live within a 1.5 mile radius of the school and for whom there will be a sibling in attendance on the admission date at the preferred school. Children who live outside a 1.5 mile radius of the school but their sibling was offered a place prior to September 2013 and will be in attendance at the time of admission. Children who live outside a 1.5 mile radius of the school but it is their closest Community or Voluntary Controlled School and for whom there will be a sibling in attendance on the admission date at the preferred school	23
3	Children who live closest to the school as measured in a direct line.	15

A waiting list will be maintained by the admissions authority until the end of the 2017 school year this will include the names of children refused admission to reception ranked in accordance with the oversubscription criteria. If a place becomes available, this will be offered for the child ranked highest at that time.
